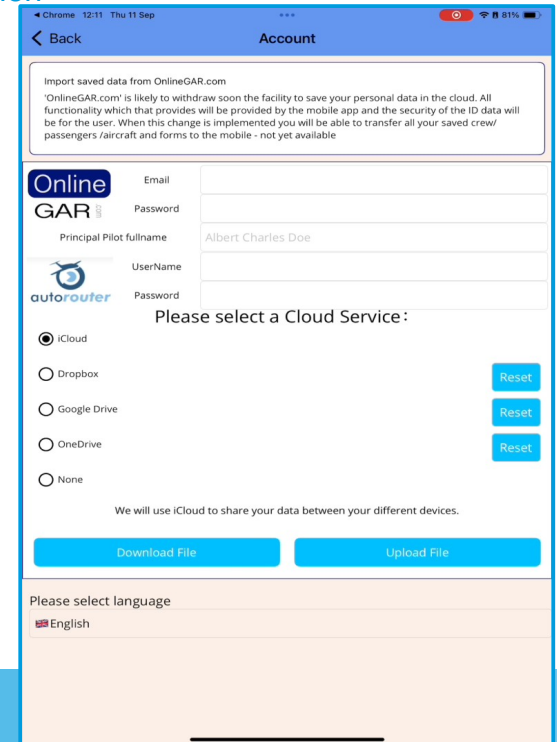
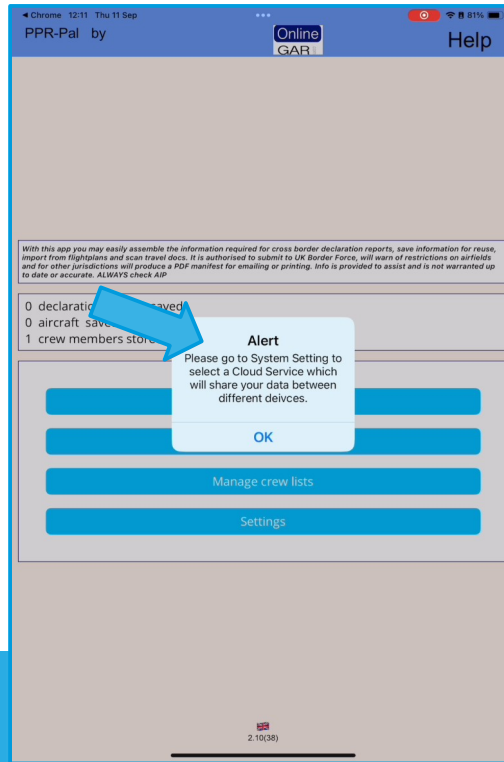
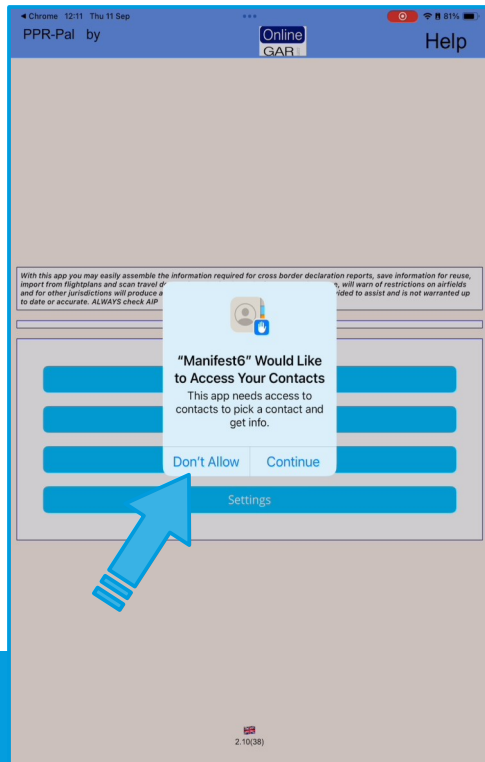

First Start up

- After installing and you start the app for the first time there are some things you need to do to get the best out of the app
- On first start up the app will prompt these – The app on all devices uses contacts to store pax/crew detail You must allow access. On ios it will ask how many contacts you want to access. Next it will ask you to set up a 'cloud' service. This enables you to sync between desktop and mobile and take your 'docs' on the road Note – this facility not available on the 'freebie' version

Setting a cloud service

- iCloud is only available on Apple devices
- Because it is integrated into the iOS system there is no more set up that checking this radio box
- After selection and a few minutes it will automatically synchronise with any manifest data ou have previously saved (obviously none on first time use)
- After setting you can force a download by pressing button but it will do it automatically in background
- On the front screen there is a note showing how many data entries you have in the cloud

Setting a cloud service DropBox

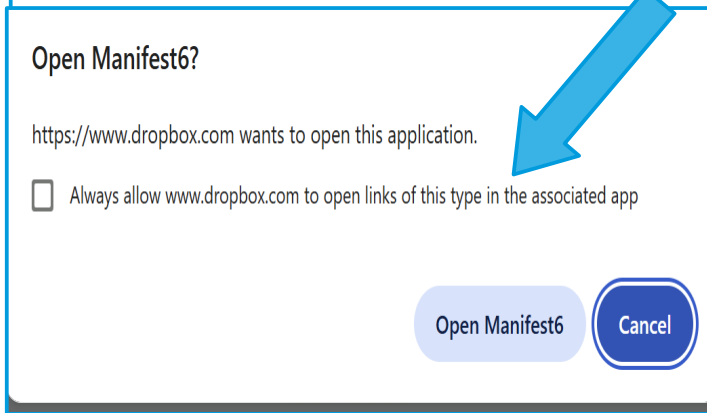
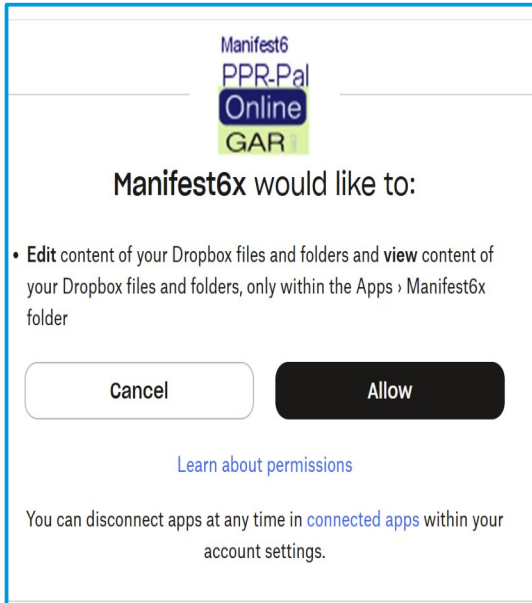

Setting up Dropbox

- Dropbox is popular but it requires you to confirm to Dropbox that you authorise its use by Manifest6. If you are selecting dropbox for the first time, goback to main menu and you will be advised to authorise through a browser – the app will take you there. Clicking reset has same effect

After this screen if you 'allow' a popup will ask you if you now want dropbox to open the app



Click on 'Open Manifest 6!' that will finally authorise Dropbox but it doesn't take you back to the app which is already open.

You can just close this browser window and Just 'switch' to the app.

(taskbar in windows, Mac= Command (⌘) + Tab , 'recent apps button in android, on iphone/pad Swipe up from the bottom and pause in the middle of the screen -

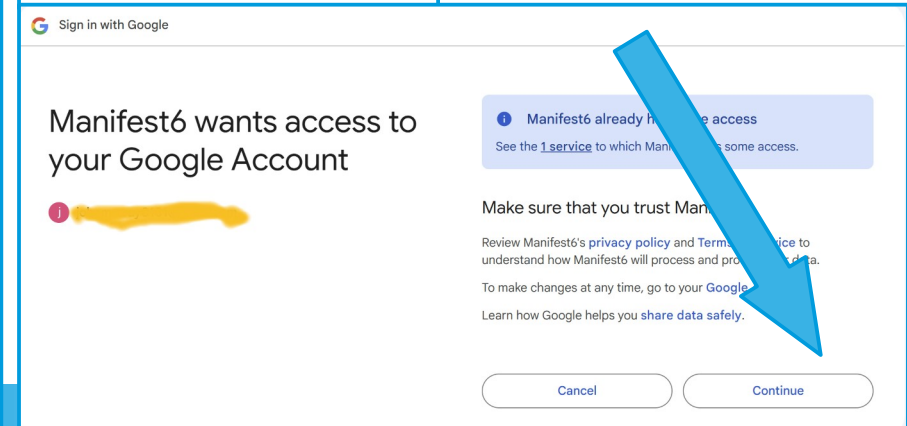
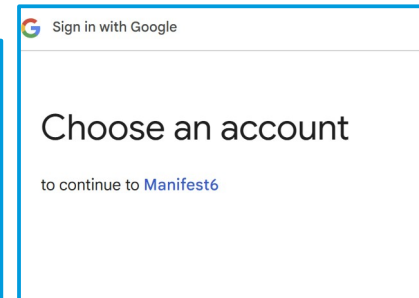
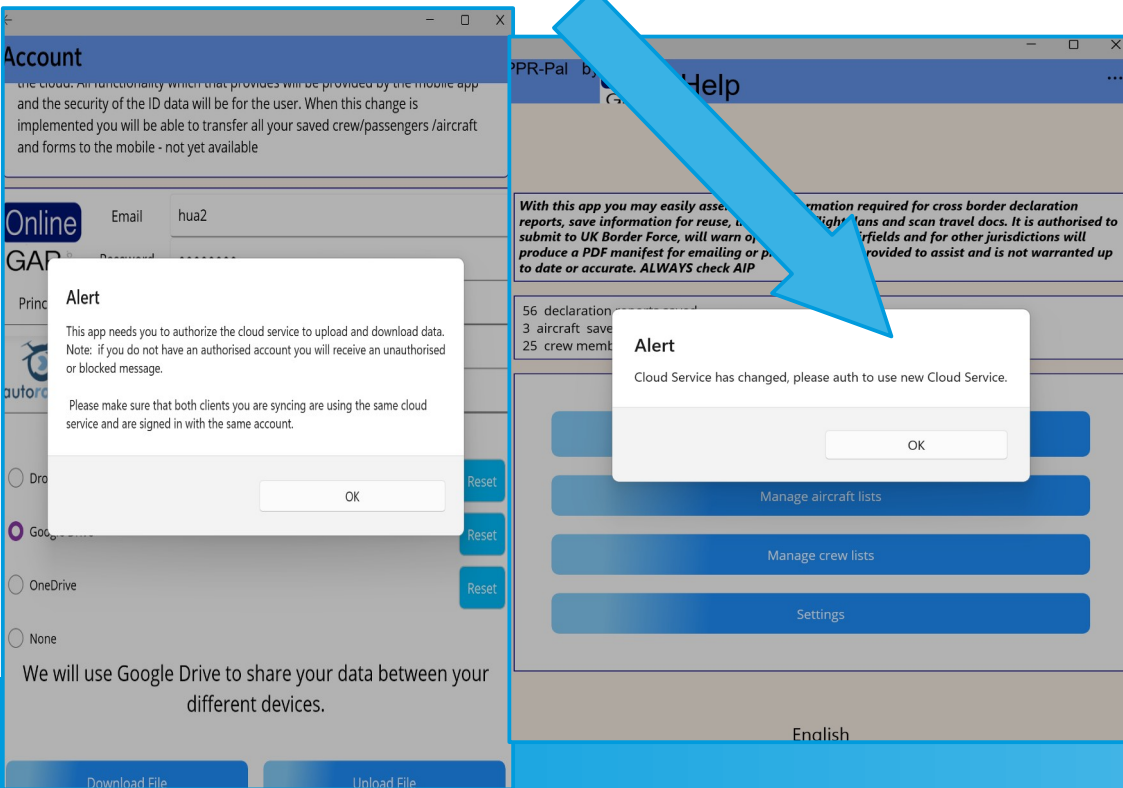
Google Drive

- In a similar way to Dropbox, Google drive must have you authorise its use by the app

After selecting Google and clicking OK now go back to main menu and another alert will appear – click OK You'll be taken to a browser

Now select which 'Drive' account you want to use (must be same on all synch'ing devices)

Click continue. Google takes a few seconds to authorise and returns to browser search bar – Like dropbox a popup asks if you want to open the app – you can click OK but it is already open Switch back to the app which is still open

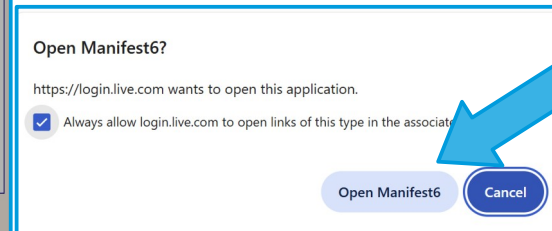
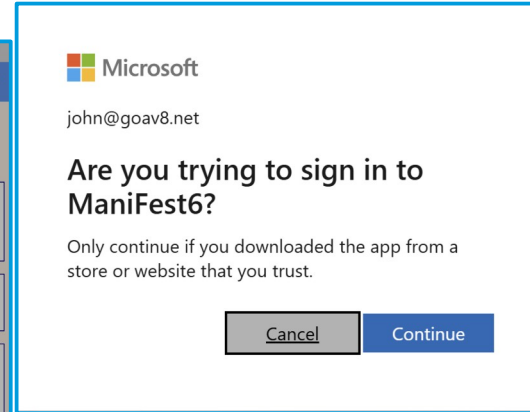
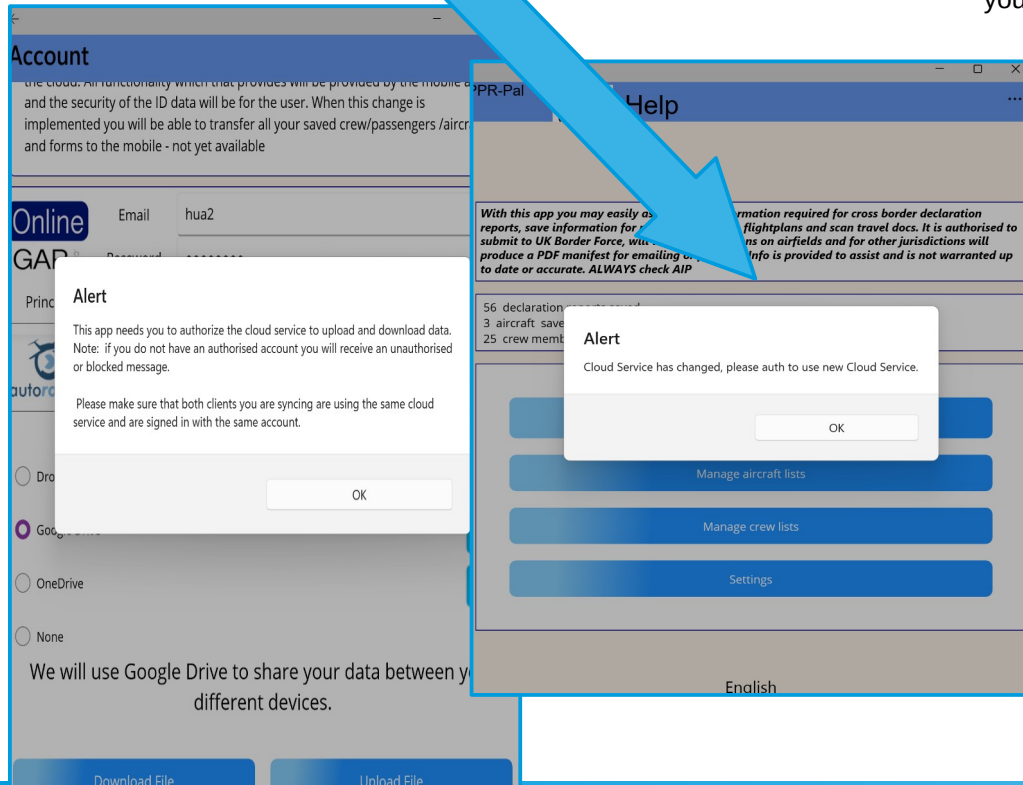

setting up OneDrive

After selecting Google and clicking Ok on warning Alert about making sure now go back to main menu and another alert will appear – click OK You'll be taken to a browser

Assuming you are logged into your microsoft account it will ask if you are trying to sign in – click continue



Click Open Manifest6 but make sure you've checked the 'always allow' box

Note: the browser will return to the previous screen – you can (2nd time around) just close this browser tab and switch back to the app
